Mining Briefs: Jupiter, Rox and more.

Tuesday, 16 October 2012

IN Mining Briefs today: Jupiter mines first manganese in South Africa; Excalibur set to acquire mine and prospecting licences in Zambia; and drill results for Rox, Latin, Nevada, Talga, Indochine and International Goldfields.

The first manganese ore has been mined at **Jupiter Mines'** Tshipi Borwa mine in South Africa.

There is now 40,000 tonnes of manganese available for processing.

"This is a key milestone for Borwa and reflects the remarkable contribution from everyone involved," Jupiter chief executive Greg Durack said.



Assay results from **Rox Resources'** newly identified Teena zinc prospect within its Myrtle/Reward project have confirmed significant mineralisation.

Highlights include 11.3m at 10.9% zinc and lead, 14 grams per tonne silver from 908.8m, 8.6m at 9.84% zinc and lead, 23gpt silver from 789.6m, 3.8m at 7.98% zinc and lead, 4gpt silver from 629.2m and 13.1m at 6.02% zinc and lead, 5gpt silver from 599.2m.

Latin Resources has intersected significant iron mineralisation during preliminary drilling at the Mariela project.

One significant intersection graded 227.15m at 37.2% iron from 542.6m, including 27.4m at 55.7% iron. While five drill holes have been completed, another five are underway.

Nevada Iron has confirmed high-grade magnetite mineralisation at its South Central deposit within the Buena Vista iron project in Nevada.

Highlights include 41.2m at 24% total iron from 6.1m, 60.9m at 32.7% total iron from 91.5m, and 6.3m at 28.1% total iron from 28.5m.

Drilling results at **Talga Gold's** Nunasvaara graphite deposit in Sweden returned spectacular graphite grades.

Highlights include 85.1m at 22.1% graphite, 33.8m at 30.5% graphite, 59.8m at 26.4% graphite and 29.1m at 31% graphite.

"The results are particularly pleasing for us as they have confirmed what the historical information indicated, and have even exceeded our expectations in some high-grade zones," managing director Mark Thompson said.

Excalibur Mining is set to acquire 100% of **Giratina**, which holds rights to earn a 64% interest in the Jessie gold mine and 80% of three Large gold prospecting licenses under application in Zambia.

The prospecting licenses include 766sq.km in the Chongwe area to the south of Lusaka.

High-grade results are continuing at **Indochine Mining's** Mt Kare gold/silver project in Papua New Guinea.

Highlights include 10m at 6gpt gold, 2.3gpt silver from 7m and 11m at 6.4gpt gold, 14gpt silver, 32m at 4.1gpt gold, 6gpt silver from 35m to 67m, which includes 4m at 17.2gpt gold and 4.3gpt silver from 35m to 39m.

Finally, **International Goldfields** has received more drilling results from its Ana Prospect within the Latin gold project in Brazil.

Highlights include, 13m at 1.96gpt gold, including 2m at 4.13gpt gold, 10m at 3.13gpt gold and 0.4% copper, 4m at 1.15gpt gold, from 56, 4m at 6.96gpt gold from 84m, 16m at 1.57gpt gold from 88m, including 4m at 4.06gpt gold, and 4m at 2.28gpt gold from 44m.
