## Mining Briefs: Heron, Oro Verde and more

### **MAKING *Mining Briefs* today: acquisitions for Oro Verde, Parmelia and Centaurus and drilling results from Heron, Latin and Anatolia.**

**Heron Resources** has intersected further massive sulphides at its Woodlawn zinc-copper project in New South Wales.

New results included 14.4m at 4.6% zinc, 4.1% copper, 0.8% lead, 1 gram per tonne gold and 57gpt silver from 374m; and 8m at 3.6% zinc, 1.3% copper, 2.6% lead, 1gpt gold and 65gpt silver from 37m.

Other new intercepts hit up to 9.8m of massive sulphides but assays are pending.

Meanwhile, **Oro Verde** has acquired an option over the Topacio gold project in Nicaragua by committing to a minimum exploration spend of \$US2 million (\$A2.3 million) over three years.

The project contains a historical NI 43-101 resource of 340,345 ounces at 3.9gpt gold and Oro Verde plans to upgrade it to JORC status.

**Parmelia Resources** has inked a \$A150,000 deal to acquire the Panda zinc-lead project in Italy.

Cominco held the project in the 1980s while Rio Tinto conducted exploration there from 2000-03.

Drilling at **Latin Resources'** Ilo Este copper project in Peru has shown improved grades.

The second hole returned best results of 0.46% copper, 2.1gpt gold, 86 parts per million molybdenum and 16gpt silver.

The third hole is underway.

**Anatolia Energy** has reported that drilling at its Sefaatli uranium project in Turkey has hit mineralisation in all 29 holes.

The best result was 6.2m at 810ppm equivalent uranium oxide from 59.8m, including 1.7m at 1490ppm equivalent uranium oxide.

Finally, **Centaurus Metals** has further extended its direct shipping ore portfolio in Brazil with the acquisition of the Candonga West project.

The prospective project is just 8km from Centaurus' proposed 300,000 tonne per annum Candonga project, which is due to start production next year.
